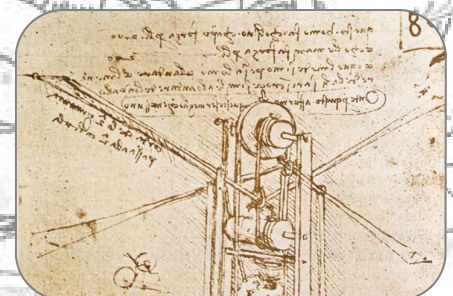
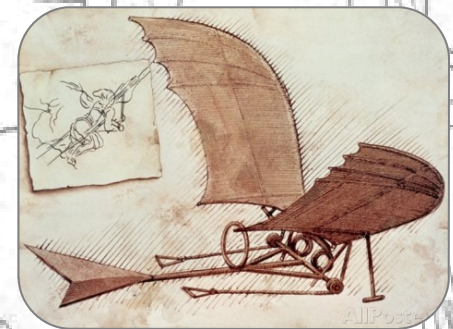
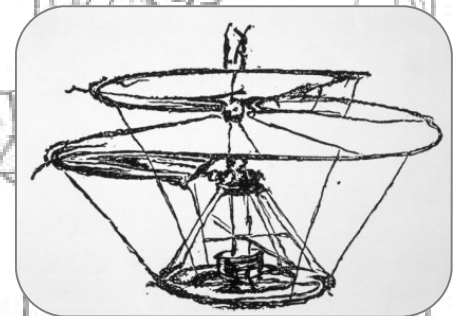
Information:

Design Brief and Conditions

- Can be created individually or in groups of up to four students
- Must be original work
- Must include a plan and a short description (250 words or less) of how the design works
- Creation must be no larger than 60cm x 60cm x 60cm
- Adhesives such as glue or sellotape may be used in addition to the three materials
- The winning creators will be required to deliver their finished work for display in the museum (this will be returned after the exhibition finishes in March 2017)
- Please include names of participating students, year level, school and teacher/s as well as a contact email and phone number
- Please email up to three photos, your plan and a description of your creation to george.mcleod@rotorualc.nz or hand deliver hard copies to the museum front desk before Friday 28 October @ 5pm. **Please do not bring models in**
- Judging will take place in the week of 31 October — 4 November
- Judges decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into
- Winners will be notified on **Friday 4 November**
- Open to students enrolled in Rotorua schools. Only year 1 — 8 students are eligible to enter
