Print out this page or if you do not have a printer take a piece of A4 paper or cartridge and draw a large cylinder on it like the one shown below.

Your aim is to paint or use pastels over this cylinder to give it an illusion of curvature and depth. To help you the percentage of the main colour to white is given. For example: 100% is just your main colour with no white added; 70% is 7 parts of the main colour to 3 parts of white; 50% is 1 part main colour to 1 part white, 20% is 2 parts main colour to 8 parts white, and 10% is 1 part of the main colour to 9 parts white.



You could use paint or pastels.
