PATTERNS MADE BY PEOPLE

A DETECTIVE GAME

You will need: a camera (you can use a mobile phone), a printer, cardboard, scissors, glue. (NB If you do not have a camera or printer you will need paper and pens/pencils).

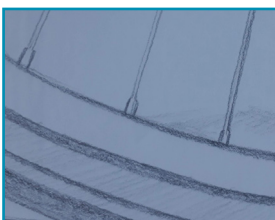
1. Take close up photos of patterns from 10 objects made by people that can be found outside (or draw them).
2. Choose 6 of the photos print them out and glue each to a piece of card. (If you are drawing, place each drawing of a pattern made by people on its own separate piece of paper or card).
3. Now get someone to find your outside patterns using the 6 cards you have made.
